## IV. President's Report: Megan Greisen

#### VI. Treasurer's Report: Mary Ann Triska - Beth reading for Mary Ann

- Account balances as of April 4, 2023
  - Checking: \$ 2,595.50 (\$ 1,732.67 when outstanding checks clear)
  - Boost Savings: \$36,329.37Savings: \$298.08Money Market: \$10,958.79
  - o Certificate: \$ 19,618.29 (Renews 5/16/2023)
- Contingency Discussion -
  - Remaining Contingency \$1,348.65
    - None.
  - Contingency Spending Requests
    - We have two spending requests that we need to go over. These aren't in our normal budget and they are asking us to help out using some of our emergency funds.
    - 2nd Grade field trip substitution
      - OMSI was going to come to the school, but that wasn't available to happen, so they are asking for another experience. OMSI was \$445, so the rice museum will be \$600 total and they are asking for the difference. They have \$152 remaining from their Dogman field trip, and because a bus wasn't budgeted, they are needing \$3. Are there questions? They are essentially wanting to reallocate the budget.
      - Christy motions to approve and Stacy seconds.
    - Kindergarten field trip to NW Children's Theater
      - They are wanting to go to NWCT Elephant and Piggie play and this is an additional request. It was not budgeted for Kindergarten. Natasya was hoping they could do it this year. Kindergarten has their own boxes and they did have a budget for those boxes. We planned for 4 classes and they only have 3 classes. There is \$100 left from that and They allocated \$200 for garden space, so that can be reallocated. I met with her about that and suggested that they ask the community for seeds. We worked together on a new garden budget. The cost for the play is \$600 for everyone and that does not include bussing. I don't have the exact amounts currently, but we can discuss:

• Christy - we only have \$1300 in Contingency and what else would we use Contingency for?

Beth - This is a lower budget for this year and we lowered it.It's main purpose is for unexpected costs or overages that may arise in the school year.

Lianne - can teachers ask for parents to pay for field trips? Megan - yes I think it can happen, but it would need to be worked out with Amanda.

Lianne - I wonder if we ask for a \$5 donation and that could help. Stacy - we did do that in first grade and people can sponsor a child. It does make it a bit harder.

Megan - moving forward, Beth is that something we need to discuss with the team?

Beth - I would like to talk with the Kindergarten team and we don't have a contingency report. We do need to let them know where we are and how the group feels.

Christy - I'm okay with using some contingency for it, but maybe not the whole thing. It seems like some is reallocated, but it's hard to know without knowing how much is needed.

Beth - Yeah, we need to meet with them and we can possibly vote on it later.
