V. Vice President's Report: Beth Rajski

 - Rachael in chat said that every student tried the broccoli and loved it.

VI. Treasurer's Report: Mary Ann Triska

- I need two volunteers for the end of year audit per the bylaws. Please let me know or email us if you would like to help.
- The budget is based off of this year, and then we adjusted a few things.
- Mary Ann proceeded to go over each line item for the budget.
 - Megan noted that the auction is scheduled for April 20th next year.
- Total operational budget is a \$14,000 budget
- The green items are from specific requests from staff that have come in so far. The unhighlighted ones are from last year's requests.
 - Beth adds to chat that she would like to add a small budget to the teacher spotlight.
- One change is for the party money to be taken off of the supplies list.
 - Rachael feels that is a great idea because it would help families that struggle, but we would need to check with Anne Flores because there may be some changes in party money.
- Mary Ann continued:
 - For school wide programs we have what was spent from last year and it's pretty similar, but there is an extra request from Poppy and she has specified what exactly she would use the money for.
 - In Literacy Megan noting that typically the author visit is in person and is usually about \$2,000. Megan Moga goes out of her way to find authors that will be on zoom to do a school wide zoom which saves a lot of money.
 - Specials funding Megan: in regards to PE, we may need to meet with Principal Small about the PE request because we did not give her the extra money, it was from the Fun Run money not our budget. I personally don't feel comfortable having to give this much from us. She probably will get the money, and that we may need to delete that before approving. Let it be known that we are Still advocating, but it will need to come from a different source and that we need to meet with Coach Bruno and Coach Cole and Principal Small about this on the budget.
 - Rachael says that she agrees and that it should not be a line item and that the fun run money will likely go to PE for the items they need.
- Mary Ann continued:
 - Mrs. Williamson did ask for extra to have 3rd grade go to the symphony. It will cost about \$700.
 - Megan notes that Keely will not need an extra \$500 because she will not be having a summer reading program.
 - Megan and MA agree that \$500 will be available for her to use just as other Special's teachers receive..
 - Christina: Going back to music and symphony, maybe Mrs.

Williamson could meet with 3rd grade?

- Rachael notes that usually the symphony comes from the music budget in the past.
- Stacy asked if Coach Bruno and Coach Cole both get \$500?
 - Mary Ann: no, that is why they are hoping for more and usually the Fun Run has helped to fund PE.
- Mary Ann continues:
 - Kindergarten didn't submit anything, so I just used what they used from this year.
- Mary Ann announces that she is open for discussion on the budget.
 - Rachael asks if there is a buffer somewhere where other classes are added and then having a buffer so that it won't be an issue with budget or needing for money.
 - Megan: I believe the class numbers will stay the same and thankfully we have enough in our budget to accommodate if it is needed.
 - Mary Ann: this is also what our contingency is for, but thank you for bringing it up.
- Mary Ann then went over each teacher's special budget and why they get a budget.
- At the end of the day we have budgeted roughly \$54,000, but we haven't spent our estimated total. We have about \$9,000 that is not allocated.
 - Megan asks if we can remove the budget for Vice Principal. That is something we don't have anymore. She switches to the agenda and asks if we should vote to approve the budget.
 - Mary Ann: Since we have \$9000 does Principal Small know how much the program she is looking into?
 - o Megan: I can sit down with Amanda to let her know where we are.
 - Mary Ann: the extra would be left in contingency.
 - Jenny had a question about the facility and maybe more fans or portable AC units.
 - Megan: It has been talked about and Amanda is also thinking about sails to help shade one side of the school. I will continue to have a conversation with her and see where she is sitting. I would feel comfortable going forward knowing that we still show that PE is getting \$500, and have more to talk to Amanda about.
 - Lianne asks if we can increase the teacher allowance?
 - Megan: That would be my pitch and my goal is to increase the teacher allowance. Sometimes the teachers don't know what to do with the money and some teachers told me that they need certain programs so I am able to purchase those.
- Mary Ann: I made a note that some line items are under contingency and that left over is still under contingency as well.
