2. Reallocation for Ms. Moga's classroom book library purchases and author visit:

    - Option 1: \$2,057.63
      - 5 Books by Aron Nels Steinke for classrooms \$657.63
      - 1 School Assembly \$400
      - 7 Classroom Workshops \$1,000 (2 classes per session / 30 min. each)
    - Option 2: \$2,257.63
      - 5 Books by Aron Nels Steinke for classrooms \$657.63
      - 1 School Assembly \$400
      - 7 Classroom Workshops \$1,000 (2 classes per session / 30 min. each)
      - 1 Evening Event \$200
    - Previously the author visit was virtual, but found a local Portland author. Book series is Mr. Wolf's Class which is a 5 book graphic novel. Graphic novels are very popular with kids, accessible for all reading levels. Reviewed two options on combining the author visit and the activities. Both options are within the previously approved budget, but allocated in

different amounts. This would adjust and combine those allocations. Ms. Moga would like the evening option. This would take place in March 2024.
